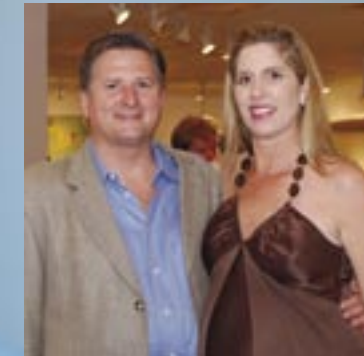
## dkVOGUE

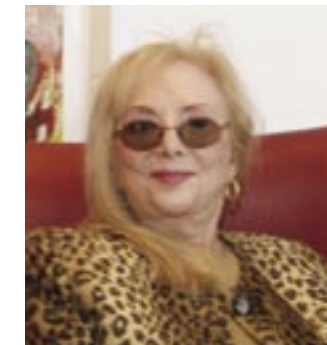
